



WELCOME SUMMER CAMP 2023

Parents / Guardians,

Thank you for your interest in Cornerstone's Camp Discovery – Summer Camp Program. This information packet will help provide you with a brief overview of our summer program.

Camp Attire

Campers should wear comfortable clothing and bring suitable shoes (example: tennis shoes or sturdy sandals). For water days, campers should wear their swim-suits to camp under their normal clothes. Please pack a pair of dry clothes, as campers will be allowed to change after swimming activities are finished. Campers should also bring sun block with them.

Camp Tuition Information

- Camp fees are due in full every Monday Morning of each week, before the camper starts his/her day.
- Camp fees are not prorated. If a camper attends one day within the week, they are billed for the entire week.
- A late fee of \$25.00 will be charged if camp fees are not paid by Monday at noon, each week.

Extended Care

Campers may participate in Extended Care, beginning as early as 6:30am and running as late as 6:00pm. There is no charge for Extended Care as it is included in the weekly camp fee.

Field Trip Information

Campers (Kindergarten & older) may participate in weekly field trips. Each field trip will cost between \$2.00 and \$27.00 dollars, in addition to the weekly camp fee. There will be 1 to 3 field trips each week. Campers are not required to attend each field trip. Field Trip Sign-Ups are accepted on a first come, first serve basis.

Lunch and Snack

Lunches are provided to campers each day and are included in the weekly camp price. However, most days lunches are cold lunches (example: turkey sub, ham sub). Campers are welcome to bring their own lunches; however, lunches cannot require heating and/or refrigerator storage. Afternoon snack is also provided to campers each day and are included in the weekly camp price.

Pick Up / Drop Off

Campers may ONLY be picked up by the person(s) authorized by the registering parent/guardian. Drop off starts at 8:00am at the front of the campus. Pick up begins at 5:00pm. Please be on time when dropping off and picking up your child.

Summer Camp Scholarship Information

Cornerstone of Jacksonville has partnered with the Kids Hope Alliance and the City of Jacksonville, to offer a Summer Camp Scholarship, to eligible children, in Kindergarten thru 11th Grade, for <u>Week #1 thru Week #6</u>. The fee for eligible children that are granted a scholarship is \$72.00, for the 6-week period (*field trips are an additional charge*). This \$72.00 fee must be paid for at the time of enrollment. *Parents must provide a copy of their child's eligibility documentation to the camp office at the time of registration. Scholarships are awarded on a first come, first serve basis. Availability is limited.* All information being requested on your child's Summer Camp Application must be completed. Any Summer Camp Application that is missing information will be rejected. Summer Camp spots fill up quickly. Therefore, it is imperative that your child's application is submitted correctly the first time. Spots are available on a first come, first serve basis.

- The Summer Camp Scholarship reduces the weekly fee from \$100.00, per week to \$12.00 per week, per child. The Scholarship covers 6-weeks, June 12, 2023 thru July 21, 2023. The \$72.00 total, (payment for the 6-weeks of Summer Camp) must be paid in full at the time the summer application is submitted (*field trips are an additional charge*).
- Campers participating under the Summer Scholarship Program must attend a minimum of 4 days, each week, during the 6-week program, for a minimum of 6 hours per day.
- Campers who will be participating under the Scholarship and then continue Summer Camp as a Self-Pay Student (for week 7) must have the \$72.00 (payment for the 6-weeks program) paid in full at the time their application is submitted **and** will then be responsible for making the weekly payment of \$100.00 on the Monday of each week that is not covered by the Summer Scholarship.
- Campers may participate in weekly field trips. Each field trip will cost between \$2.00 and \$27.00 dollars. There are one to three field trips each week. Campers are not required to attend every field trip.

Participant Eligibility

To be eligible for participation in the KHA Scholarship Program, child must be:

- Residents of Duval County (only)
- Kindergarten to Rising 11th Grade*
 - * Children must be five years old by Sept. 1 <u>AND</u> be entering kindergarten this fall.

AND;

Special Needs/Special Education - Documented by one of the following:

- A form/letter from a school with the child's name and current school year date
- A McKay Scholarship (as documented by a form from the school with the child's name and current school year date)
- A current diagnosis report from a medical or psychological professional verifying that the child would require an Individual Education Plan (IEP) if enrolled in the public-school system **OR**

Community Eligible Child (DCPS) - Documented By:

 Children enrolled in one of the Duval County Public Schools (DCPS) that are participating in the National Student Lunch and School Breakfast Programs that classified as 100% Free/Reduced Lunch for the (2022-2023) school year (CEP School Site) documented by a child's report card (2022-2023) showing attendance at one of the eligible schools.

Lives in the boundaries of or attends a DCPS Title 1 School - Documented By:

• Children that live in the boundaries of or attends a DCPS Title 1 school, documented by a child's report card (2022-2023) showing attendance and/or home address at one of the eligible schools. **OR**

Students with Family Income at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty Level - Documented by one of the following:

- A current copy of a Step-Up for Students Scholarship award letter, or another Florida Tax Credit Scholarship, or
- Documentation of Temporary Assistances for Needy Families, WIC, and/or Medicaid, or
- Verification that household family income does not exceed 185% of the Federal Poverty Level
